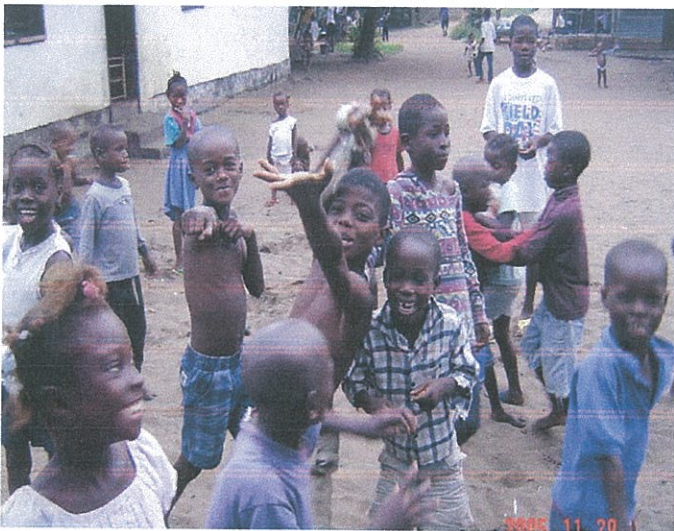

I am so grateful for the kind gesture you and your family keep rendering to the kids and the entire home. I've received the cash you sent through my account. The orphanage is growing day after day. Presently we've thirteen grown up pigs and twenty- four piglets. We've in total eighteen chickens, they were twenty-five, unfortunately seven died. We've four laying eggs presently. Extend our greetings to Sarah, David and their mother.

The kids eat some of the pigs on holidays. From this money I bought a generator for the home. It's a wonderful

season indeed after so many periods of darkness. The children will now study under light. We used the balance one hundred twenty-five for soup kinds. Through God blessings, we were able to built three classrooms on campus. So the kids are in school on campus. The school is presently operating classes from Nusery- seven grade.
